# FOUNDED IN 1946 BY ARTISTS, FOR ARTISTS

**Skowhegan School of Painting & Sculpture** is one of the country's foremost educational experiences for artists. Located on a 350-acre campus in Maine, the nine-week program provides emerging artists and faculty artists with a collaborative and rigorous environment that is shaped by risk-taking, mentorship, and peer-to-peer exchange. Skowhegan's merit-based admissions process ensures that we accept the most promising and cutting-edge artists of each generation, regardless of financial or educational backgrounds.

For Skowhegan's 75th Anniversary, we embarked on a years-long effort to expand the institution's capacity to support emerging visual artists from every background. Our successes, realized through the **75th Anniversary Campaign**, advance core values by upgrading the campus facilities to better house participants and staff and engage emerging art practices; growing the endowment to preserve need-blind admissions and artistic autonomy; prioritizing local investments that bolster regional food economies and environmental priorities; and publishing the first major book on Skowhegan's history and impact.

Thanks to contributions from artists, foundations, Trustees, Governors, and supporters, the 75th Anniversary Campaign (2018–2022) raised more than \$21 million—the most significant fundraising effort in Skowhegan's history. These efforts will ensure that Skowhegan remains a place that engages the next generation of artists in the most urgent conversations about the evolving nature of artmaking and its future.



Dear Skowhegan Community,

Thank you! When we assumed the role of co-chairs for Skowhegan's 75th Anniversary Campaign, we knew the school was beloved, but we couldn't have imagined the outpouring of support we would receive from over 1,300 of you over the last five years. You have helped us restore and build our campus; grow the endowment; embark on an ambitious new publication about Skowhegan's history; and ensure that every day since we launched this campaign, Skowhegan has had the ability to support artists and advance its mission-driven projects.

Skowhegan's campaign spanned five calendar years (2018–2022) and the comprehensive approach is reflective of the interconnected way this institution functions. Our goals were established through an iterative and community-driven process that involved extensive input and discussion from alumni, faculty, staff, Governors and Trustees. The priorities honor Skowhegan's foundational mission of inclusion and open access to all accepted artists and the singular character of our rural campus. The extraordinary circumstances around COVID could not have been imagined, and yet the goals embodied by this campaign became a roadmap to navigate through the moment of precarity by advancing programmatic priorities. Indeed, the rallying support around the school in 2020 reaffirmed the depth and determination of this community.

For more than seven decades, Skowhegan has seen the transformational impact that happens when artists live and work exclusively alongside other artists. The 75th Anniversary Campaign expands our capacity to support emerging artists as they engage fully with their peers, distinguished faculty, and mentors over nine weeks of expansive thinking, material experimentation, and broadened perspectives.

As we look ahead to the next 75 years, and 5,000 more artists who will live and work at Skowhegan, we are humbled by the potential of that creative input in the world. Thank you for partnering with Skowhegan to sustain the future of artmaking!

# MASTER PLAN PROJECTS

Skowhegan's campus is set upon open fields, preserved and stewarded forests, rolling hills, and the shores of Lake Wesserunsett. The following principles guide Skowhegan's vision for its buildings and grounds and were the driving principles for the Master Plan projects realized between 2018 and 2023.

- Skowhegan's facilities should be innovative and responsive to changes in the art world
- The landscape and environment, and the isolation they offer, are critical programmatic components
- Campus facilities should promote innovation and experimentation, as well as health, safety and equity
- Skowhegan's buildings & grounds should reflect and preserve the School's rich history
- Spaces should be neutral and flexible for use by any individual or group
- Spaces on campus should be balanced for heightened and intentional community interaction and also allow for solitude and silence





# PUBLICATION

Skowhegan's forthcoming book will be the first major study of the school's history and philosophy. Co-authored by art historian and editor Faye Hirsch, and writer and curator Ingrid Schaffner, the book draws from primary source material including: Skowhegan's document and lecture archives in New York City and Maine; new in-depth interviews and roundtable discussions with faculty, alumni, and leadership; photographs, film, and ephemera; and materials from the Smithsonian Archives of American Art as well as other sources. By uncovering narratives on Skowhegan and providing an institutional record, we hope this project will inspire other artists and institutions, and help shape future research and conversations on the American art scene and art education.



## THE FUTURE FUND

Initiated by Marina Kellen French and Andrew Gundlach in honor of their parents and grandparents, The Anna-Maria & Stephen Kellen Foundation Future Fund is Skowhegan's largest endowment gift to date. ## THE DAVID FUND

David Beitzel (A '82) was a dedicated member of the Skowhegan community. He helped found Skowhegan's 21st Century Committee to engage his generation of artists, arts professionals, and patrons, and in 2009, became a Trustee. As Development Committee Chair for nearly a decade, he fostered a strong network of allies who share his passionate commitment to emerging visual artists, in particular LGBTQ artists and artists of color.

Skowhegan is stronger as a result of David's leadership and generosity, and we honor his legacy through The David Fund created in partnership and love with his devoted partner Darren Walker, his brother Skip Beitzel, sister Tish Vredenburgh, and their families.

The David Fund provides urgent support for artists on campus so that they can maximize their time in Maine. Although Skowhegan covers tuition for any artist in need, many participants are financially insecure. The David Fund is directed in real time by the Directors, and enables Skowhegan to be nimble and responsive to changing needs of participants, fostering their collective experience while recognizing and supporting their individual circumstances.





## THE CUMMINGS FUND

The Cummings Family Fund honors founding artist Willard "Bill" Cummings and his singular vision for a summer art school on his family's farm in rural Maine. The priority of the Fund is the upkeep and maintenance of Red Farm, the historic 1789 farm house in the heart of Upper Campus and the surrounding gardens, though it may also support other grounds and maintenance projects. Skowhegan's campus is inextricable from the program, and these dedicated funds help preserve the school's rural campus in perpetuity.

# THANK YOU

Skowhegan was founded *by* artists, *for* artists, and by estimation there are about 5,500 artists who have helped shape Skowhegan since it was founded in 1946 as students/participants, faculty, Governors, and program staff. Into this mix comes a small number of close allies: over nearly eight decades roughly 300 Trustees and Governors and around 100 staff have worked to advance the mission, furthered in their efforts by a circle of friends and supporters. As we conclude the 75th Anniversary Campaign and Campus Master Plan, we see the full impact of this artist community, and its circle of advocates, coming together in an extraordinary way.

In Maine, Bill Holmes, Ralph Drouin, Kevin Flanagan, Peter Jillson and Ronald Pinkham represent 108 years of combined service to Skowhegan.
